Polytechnic, at the premises no.- nil, Barerlya, P.S. Bagmudi, P.O. Pathardih, Over R.S Plot no. 448, JL no. 103, Mouza- Barerlya, District- Purulia. Pin - 723152.

The plan submitted by you was scrutinized and marked as found necessary from Fire Safety point of view. In returning one set of plan with recommendation, this is issuing Fire Safety Recommendation in favour of the aforesaid building subject to the compliance of the following fire safety measure.

Recommendation:

1. Construction:

1. The whole construction of the proposed building shall be carried out as per approved plan drawings conforming the relevant building rules of local Municipal Body.

2. The floor area exceeds 750m<sup>2</sup> shall be suitably compartmented by separation walls up to ceiling level having at least two hours Fire resisting capacity.

Open Space & Approach:

3. The open space surrounding the building shall conform the relevant building rules as well as permit the accessibility and manoeuvrability of Fire appliance with turning facility.

4. The approach roads shall be sufficiently strong to withstand the load of Fire Engine weighing up to 20 MT.

5. The width and height of the access gates into the premises shall not be less than 4.5 - 5 M respectively abutting the road.

Staircase:

6. Provision for at least two exits in all the multi storied buildings, accessible from each floor and each building and as remote from each other as practicable shall be made and they shall be so arranged that they are accessible in at least two different directions from every point in any open area, or from any door.

Fire Fighting Water:

7. Overhead reservoir of 10,000 ltrs. capacity exclusively for Fire fighting purpose with replenishing arrangements @ 1000 ltrs./min. Preferably from two different sources of water supply shall be provided. The water reservoir shall have overflow arrangement with the domestic water reservoir as well as to avoid stagnancy of water. The water reservoir shall be kept full at all time.

Hose reel System:

8. Provision of standard Hose Reel Hose supplied from the overhead reservoir through Booster Pump, 10HP capacity, shall have to be made in all the floor of the building satisfy the code of I.S. 3844-1969.

Electrical Installation & Distribution:

9. The electrical installation shall be adequately protected with M.C.B & CO2/D.C.P.

First Aid Fire Fighting System:

10. First Aid Fire fighting arrangement in the style of placing suitable type of portable Fire Extinguishers, at least 2 " 8 kg capacity ABC & 2"4 S.KG CO<sub>2</sub> type for every 600 sq. meter floor area or part thereof, with minimum 4 Extinguishers per floor & Fire Buckets etc. in all floors and vulnerable locations of the premises shall be made as per latest specification.

General Recommendations:

11. The teaching and non-teaching staffs of the school shall be conversant with installed Fire Fighting equipment of the building and to operate in the event of Fire and Testing.

12. Arrangement shall be made for regular checking, testing and proper maintenance of all the Fire Safety installation and equipment's installed in the building to keep them in perfectly

good working conditions at all times.

13. Mock Fire practice and evacuation drill shall be performed periodically with participation of all occupants of building.

14. Each year a certificate is to be obtained from the Director General, West Bengal Fire & Emergency Services certifying about the satisfactory services, performance of all the Life and Fire Safety arrangements and installation of the building.

15. This shall be tested as provisional N.O.C. On compliance of all the above Fire and Life safety recommendations, the Director General, West Bengal Fire & Emergency Services shall be approached for necessary inspection and testing of the installation. Final N.O.C. in favour of the occupancy shall be issued on being satisfied with the tests and performances of safety aspects of installation of the building.

16. **The technical institution shall publish an information booklet before commencement of the academic year giving details regarding the institution and courses / programs being conducted and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form of mandatory disclosure. The information booklet may be made available to the stakeholders of the technical education. The mandatory disclosure information, as per directions in the AICTE website / Approval Process Handbook, shall be put on the Institution Website. The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the institution.**
17. **It shall be mandatory for the technical institution to maintain a Website providing the prescribed information. The Website information must be continuously updated as and when changes take place.**
18. **If a technical Institution fails to disclose the information or suppress and / or misrepresent the information, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the Institution.**
